

MATHS

Both year 1 and 2 will be focusing on the fundamentals of number and place value this term, consolidating their knowledge from last year. This will give them the firm knowledge and confidence to move on to addition and subtraction towards the end of the half term.

After half term year 1 will learn about properties of shape, money and then return to addition and subtraction. Year 2 will continue with increasingly complex addition and subtraction learning and then start to learn about multiplication and division.

HISTORY

We will be learning about changes in living memory this term, we will begin the year learning about the differences between when Mrs Worley was 5 and now we are 5. We will be comparing our homes, school and our toys seeing how they have changed and how they are the same!

We will also be concentrating on using language associated with the passing of time, sorting objects into past and present and having fun with "historical objects" like a VCR and Walkman!

PSHCE

In PSHCE we will be using the 1 Decision program and will be looking at keeping ourselves safe! This includes when out and about and road safety. Pre Prep will also be looking for Hazards in the home and discussing what is safe to eat and drink and what is safe to play with.

LITERACY

In Phonics we will be consolidating the letters and sounds the children have already covered, then progressing at each child's own phase level. Weekly spellings will be sent home to learn, beginning with those we can sound out to more complex words with new spelling patterns. We will be continuing our work on sentence writing, introducing the use of nouns and adjectives through retelling traditional stories, report writing, explanations and poetry.

Year 1 and 2 Autumn Term Time Travellers!

RE

This year, Year 1 and 2 will focus on the religions of Christianity and Judaism as well as looking at some traditions of other religions. The first half term we will be focusing on and exploring the question, 'What do some people believe about God? As we move into the second half of the term, we will be thinking about Christmas and how it is celebrated. As traditions within Christianity and within in our homes.

SCIENCE

This term Pre-Prep will begin by learning about 'Ourselves'. We will learn fascinating things about our bodies and senses! We will observe changes over time and think about the question, 'How do we change as we get older?' We will collect data, look for patterns and carry out investigations.

Through out the term we will also be looking at other animals that are different to ourselves, and being encouraged to make predictions and test our

Mrs Henley will be leading Pre Prep's art lessons and they will they are revisiting the theory of colour. They will be looking at colour related to the seaside and holidays and later in the term autumn colours by mixing primary's to get secondary colours

PE

During this term in outdoor PE Pre Prep will be looking at running and jumping. We will be finding out different ways to travel and looking at different purposes for jumping (for height or distance for example. This will culminate in making a jumping sequence.

In the first half of the term indoor PE will be focusing on gymnastics, mainly on balancing and working with a partner to create a sequence.
